

infants

0-12 months

The goal of our infant nursery ministry is to provide parents with a safe and secure environment that enables them to worship and learn effectively without distraction or worry. Although separation can be difficult, over time children adapt and establish a routine. The age range for infant nursery is 0-12 months and children are steady walkers.

toddlers

12-24 months

The goal of our toddler nursery ministry is the same as our infant ministry to provide parents with a safe and secure environment that enables them to worship and learn effectively without distraction or worry. Although separation can be difficult, over time children adapt and establish a routine. The age range for toddlers is 12-24 months.

preschool

3-5 years

Our preschool ministry begins when a child turns 2 years old (24 months). Although childcare is still a main focus, we strive to be more intentional by providing a structured teaching, singing, and activity time. During this time in the preschool ministry, each child will have interacted with both the Old and New Testaments as a whole, seeing how God has shown us Who He is. Our Preschool 2 ministry is for children who are at least 2 years old. Similarly, our Preschool 3 and Preschool 4 ministries are for children who are at least 3 and 4 years old respectively. Children will advance each year 1 month after their birthday.

k-3rd grade

In this part of our ministry the focus shifts from providing childcare to maximizing our efforts for each child to encounter the God of the Bible and His call on their life. The main elements of our time are interactive play, worship through singing, engaging teaching and small group discussion and application. Because parents shoulder the responsibility of training their children to know God, we provide weekly take home content that we pray will be an aid in this most crucial endeavor.

4th-5th grade

We view this stage of our ministry as a staging ground for the teenage years. While the above format is the same, our teaching is separate. The students are engaged at a deeper level in order to help them grow in their faith. Students in 4th and 5th grade are also invited to participate in monthly events known as The Rock. These events are designed to build relationships and strengthen bonds as the students graduate into junior high ministries. To enable a smoother transition to the main service, 4th-5th grade does not meet on the 4th or 5th Sunday of the month.
